

Check List of vaccinations for Dogs

Attending Dog Training

When accepting applications for dog training, you MUST BE CHECKING that the puppy or dog has the adequate vaccination shots to attend the class.

Each puppy/dog requires the following shots:

1. Five-way shot – usually given 8 weeks, 12 weeks and 16 weeks and yearly for mature dogs. Is the puppy on time with its shots? The five-way shot includes: Corona, Distemper, Hepatitis, Parainfluenza, and Parvo.
2. Rabies
3. Bordatella (commonly known as Kennel Cough). This is not usually included with the regular vaccinations. The customer may have to special request it from their vet.

To protect the health of the dogs attending the class, they **MUST ALL HAVE ALL OF THE ABOVE SHOTS INCLUDING KENNEL COUGH.**

THIS MUST BE DONE MINIMUM 10 DAYS PRIOR TO FIRST CLASS TO ENSURE THE DOG HAS PROPER IMMUNIZATION.
